CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Councillor R Butcher with the help of the respective Chairman/Vice Chairman read out his detailed Annual Report to the meeting and thanked the Councillors and staff for their work over the year, a copy of the report is available on the Parish Council's website.

QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS

Mr Bolton, a resident, thanked the Parish Council for their work over the past 12 months adding that they had done a Stirling job during difficult times. He expressed a wish to be involved in any working group that may be set up to deal with the speeding issues along Broadway.

County Councillor M McGuire apologised over the problems experienced with the delivery of the highway projects and the filling of potholes. He advised that he had spoken with Steve Cox, Executive Director of Place & Economy at Cambridgeshire County Council and had expressed great concern over the apparent deterioration of the delivery of the projects and maintenance. The service was being reviewed with an aim to make major improvements. Councillor McGuire also mentioned the Definitive Map Modification Order to record a public footpath between Hawthorn Road and Windsor Road which he had asked Officers to prioritise.
